

SEVENTY-FIRST--MEETING
VALLEY CIVIC LEAGUE

July 29, 1938

Meeting called to order by the pres.

Report from Mun Iseri on the picnic. The date for the picnic to be August 14th, to be held at Redondo Beach and the Spanish Castle. Redondo Beach to rent for \$20.00 and the Castle for \$120.00. For the dance, the fee will be \$1.00 a couple or sixty cents for gentlemen and forty cents for ladies.

Each chapter to furnish their own refreshments. The picnic committee to meet and decide upon the food.

Report given by Thos. Iseri on the last Board meeting held in Seattle.

Members asked to submit their songs to the Courier office or Takeo Nogaki. These songs to be sung at the Nat'l convention.

Members who are certain of going to Los Angeles are: Mr. and Mrs. Thos. Iseri, Mike Iseri, Mun Iseri, Mae Iseri, Masako Tsujikawa, Jack Hori and our president. Delegates to have hats designating which chapter they represent. Those delegates going by train have been given a twenty-five day limit. Train leaves August 30th.

Tomio gave the treasurer's report. The league has a balance of \$50.69.

Letter read from the Nat'l treasurer informing us that our league is \$16.00 behind in dues for the Pacific Citizen. There is also a delinquency of \$5.00 from last year.

These debts are to be paid before the Nat'l convention.

Minoru read several letters from the Nat'l convention headquarters. One concerning the golf tournament and the other outlining the program for the convention and the various discussion groups.

Motion made and passed that the league sponsor a picture show in order to raise funds to send the two official delegates to Los Angeles.

Meeting to be held next Friday, August 5th, tickets for picture show and picnic and dance to be distributed then. Price on picture show set at \$1.25 per family and fifty cents for a single person.

Tomio and Martin Hirabayashi appointed to make arrangements for said show.

Two alternate delegates were chosen. Those elected are Mike and Mun Iseri.

Motion made and passed that the meeting be adjourned.
