

SEVENTY-THIRD--MEETING
VALLEY CIVIC LEAGUE

November 18, 1938

The meeting was called to order by the president.

The sum of \$9.65 was spent by our league for participation in the Veterans of Foreign Wars Armistice Day dance, at which time the girls served the folks tea and cookies.

Min called our attention to the JACL pins now on sale for \$1.25 for the gold filled pins and \$2.25 for the ten karat pin. Order to be filled by the 30th of November.

Letter read from the Portland JACL asking our cooperation for submitting a pledge of \$25.00 from our chapter. They are also asking individual pledges.

George Terada was appointed chairman for the get-together dinner. Those serving upon his committee are: John Dodobara, Taeko Yasumura and Emily Nishimura.

A committee of three to be chosen by the members in December at the regular meeting. This committee to choose officers for election in January.

The treasurer's report shows a balance of \$22.08.

No further business; meeting adjourned.
