Discussion held on membership drive. This drive is to begin from the month of February to the 3rd of March.


Tee Okura and Mun Iseri were appointed as permanent captains for the coming term by the president.

Motion was made and carried that either side who brings new member gets to keep his man.


Emily Nishimura was appointed to be in charge of the JACL pins.
