## EIGHTY-FIFTH -- MEETING VALLEY CIVIC LEAGUE

Motion was carried. The committees chosen by the president were as follows: Charles Toshi, installation and initiation; Willie Maebori to contact public officials; and Keo Murakami and Mary Tomosada, co-chairmen of the dance.

Motion was made and seconded that the VCL will sponsor flower show which will be presented by the Women's Committee of the JACL. Motion was carried.

Motion was made and seconded to start the membership and census drive immediately, and to have committee meeting on March second. The next league meeting will be on March fifteenth. Motion carried.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
