Report was given by Keo Murakami on the dance. Expenditures amounted to \$69.70. Gross profit \$88.00. Net profit \$18.30.


Report on the Women's Committee was given by Mrs. Geo. Yasumura. \$5.00 fee for the rental of the church hall was paid for the presentation of the flower show.


The treasurer's report was given by Tomio Itabashi,
