

NINETY-SIXTH--MEETING

Motion carried.


A donation of five dollars (\$5.00) was acknowledged from Mr. and Mrs. H. Hiranaka.


Collected five cents (5¢) from each members for the "jackpot" drawing which is to be drawn at the next meeting. Tomio Itabashi was appointed chairman by the president.
