Mrs. George Yasumura was unanimously elected the chairman for this group.

This meeting, an informal one, was carried on as a discussion group, with each member present giving her views.

Suggestions made for various projects that we could undertake were:

1. To have lecture on some concrete subjects that would be of benefit.
2. Lessons on personal charm.
3. To take up child care - get list of names of good books for reference.
4. Health lessons.
5. Cooking and flower arrangement classes.

The group will meet monthly on Wed. evn.
Afternoon if they decide to do so. Simple re-
freshments costing about 50¢ will be served
at each meeting. Expense to be financed by
the league.

A suggestion has been made to use an
upstairs room of the Japanese Language School
for our monthly meetings. Mae Iseki was
asked to look into this matter. If available
the group is to find ways and means of fixing
the room for a cozy atmosphere.

Yacko Kaji was appointed publicity re-
porter of our group.
