A motion was made and seconded that ~~five~~ dollars be paid to the tresurer of the Northwest District Council Board. Motion carried.


The social to be held in the near future was left up to the officers to be decided.

A letter was read from the Los Angeles Chapter of the J. A. C. L. stating that the National Convention will be held on July 27th, 28th, and 29th.


The two delegates to be sent to the National Convention will be appointed at the next meeting.
