Motion was made and seconded that we sell ice cream sandwiches at the dance. Motion carried.


Motion was made and seconded that two girls be appointed to take care of the patrons and patronesses.

John Arima


A suggestion was made for guarding cars at the dance that the boys take turns at watching.
