## Passenger Information

**BAGGAGE**—Free weight allowance—on local tickets between continental U. S. and Hawaii, 55 pounds (25 kilos); on all other Pacific services, 66 pounds (30 kilos); Around the World, 88 pounds (40 kilos). Excess baggage charges— $\frac{1}{2}$  of 1% of the normal adult one-way fare per pound (1% per kilo).

**CANCELLATION & SERVICE CHARGES**—If your plans change please cancel your reservations promptly to avoid disappointing others. Failure to cancel will result in a service charge of 25% of the one-way fare to destination to which space has been reserved, or to the first stopover of more than six hours duration shown on ticket. However, such service charge will not exceed \$50.00 U. S. Currency.

**CHILDREN**—One child under two years of age and not occupying a seat will be carried free with accompanying full fare passenger. Children two to twelve will be charged half fare.

**EQUIPMENT**—On its Pacific Services, Pan American operates comfortable four-engine Clippers (DC-4 type) equipped with exclusive "Sleeperette" chair-lounge seating.

**FARES**—All fares quoted herein apply from airport to airport and are subject to change without notice. They do not include the cost of applicable ticket taxes, ground transportation, or hotel and ground meal expense.

**IN-FLIGHT SERVICE**—Each Clipper flying the Pacific carries a Purser and Steward or Stewardess to serve you while in flight.

**MEALS**—Delicious hot meals and light refreshments are served aloft without charge.

**PASSPORTS AND VISAS**—Passengers must have all valid documents such as permits, passports and/or other certificates, required by the laws of the countries from, into or over which they are to fly. Consult any Pan American office or agency and consuls of the various countries for information.

**RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT**—All reservations must be made in advance through authorized travel agents or any office of Pan American World Airways. Deposit or full fare is payable upon confirmation of reservations. In case of deposit, full fare is payable 15 days prior to scheduled departure date.

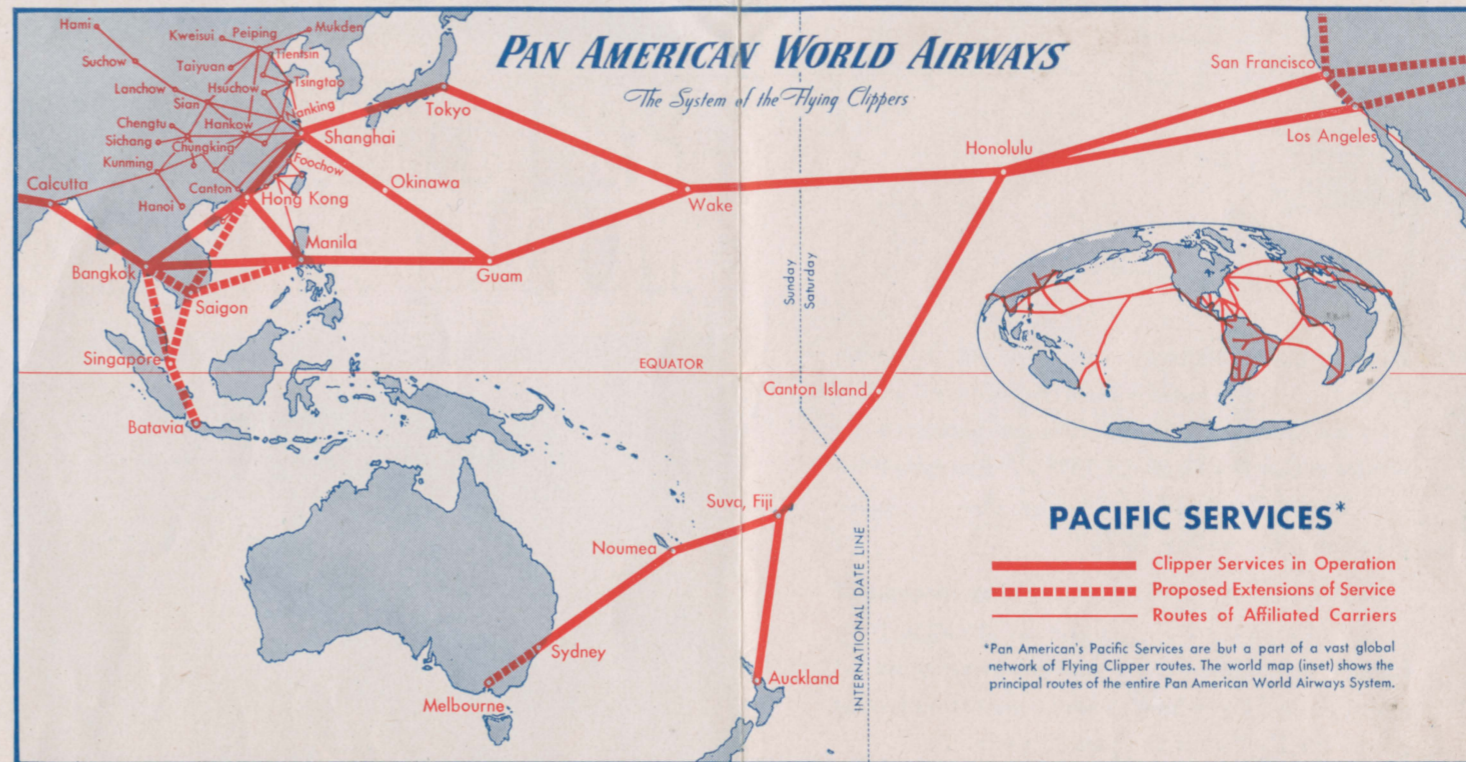
**STOPOVERS**—Stopovers may be arranged at scheduled stops at the time you purchase your tickets.
