BEST MAKES SPECIAL STATEMENT

Operation of Tule Lake Center is proceeding as usual, R. R. Best, project director, said today in a special statement to center residents following the two-day holiday which was declared when President Truman announced Tuesday night that the Japanese Government has signified officially its intention to surrender and end the war.

"All workers of Tule Lake Center, except those engaged in maintenance of essential services, had a double holiday Wednesday and Thursday," said Best, "as a special memorial to the peace that now is to prevail between the United States and Japan. Now all

operations in the center are proceeding as usual, and will continue to do so in an orderly fashion. There has been no change in the relationship or the necessity for cooperation between the Administration and the center residents.

"I cannot at this time answer the questions that I know many of you are asking regarding changes the ending of the war eventually may bring about in the status of the various residents or of the center itself.

"Whatever changes may be decided upon by the United States Government, or any of its agencies, affecting Tule Lake Center will be made in an orderly

manner and with full consideration of the situation of the residents--of that I can assure you.

"Whenever any information is received from Washington which in any way will affect the future of any residents of the center, the people of Tule Lake Center will be informed promptly.

"I wish at this time to express my sincere appreciation of the cooperation Tule Lake residents have given in the orderly operation and maintenance of this center, and to express also my full confidence that this will be continued in the much less trying days of peace that are to come."

FIRES AT 5218, 4306 REPORTED

Two minor fires, one at Mess 5218 at 12 noon on Aug. 9 and the other at 4306-D Sunday morning, were reported last week, according to Clifford Parker, new fire protection officer.

The fire at the Block 52 mess hall was caused by ignition of stored kindling wood and paper in the boiler room due to extreme heat. Fire engines #1 and #3 quickly extinguished the blaze to check the damage at \$12.

Careless smoking at 4306-D burned bedding and clothing. Loss at this fire was estimated at \$20.

FOR PAINTING

OUTPATIENT CLINIC TO BE CLOSED AUG. 27 TO SEPT. 2

The Outpatient Clinic will be closed from Aug. 27 to Sept. 2, inclusive, to permit painting of the building, the hospital announced today.

During that week, all of the regularly scheduled hospital clinics, with two exceptions, will be dropped. The two exceptions are as

follows: (1) The Immunization Clinic will be at the Colony Dispensary on Aug. 29 to treat residents at the usual time. (2) Dr. Donnell Boardman's special clinics will be at the dispensary on Aug. 27 and Aug. 30.

The hospital dental clinic will also be closed during the one-week period.

Residents with appointments to the Outpatient Clinic for the week of Aug. 27 are requested to report to the dispensary now to receive new appointments for the following week.

Only emergency cases will be handled at the dispensary while the Outpatient Clinic is closed. Evacuees needing attention after regular hours are asked to telephone 3401 as is done under regular operation procedure.

The Army Processing Station has informed the Administration that Tule Lake Center residents who have lost their Army Identification Badges should claim them at the Processing Station as soon as possible.
