

RESULT OF BUYING TRIP

Tatsuno, Fujita Return

In spite of their first telegraphic report from St. Louis which said, "Buying outlook dark", Dave Tatsuno and Tad Fujita returned to Topaz last week with almost \$45,000 worth of dry goods purchased.

It took a lot of leg work. Eighty firms in all were contacted and purchases were made from sixty; 8 in Salt Lake; 2 in Denver; 20 in St. Louis, and 30 in Chicago.

Among the purchases are \$12,000 worth of piece goods --- cotton percale prints, sheers, piques, seersuckers, organdies, jerseys, and chambrays. These goods will be placed on sale without announcement as soon as they come in, in order to avoid conjection and confusion.

Other items purchased include baby items, chenille robes, ladies anklets and belts; notions including elastics, snaps, safety pins, metal zippers, bobbie pins, buttons and ribbons.

Men's wear figured large in the purchases and include army-twill trousers, shirts, and part wool slacks.

Fall goods were difficult to buy except some items for immediate payment and shipment. Other goods will be increasingly difficult to obtain in the future. Two of the largest wholesale houses in St. Louis have been forced to cancel all business with relocation centers because their supply was too small for even their regular, permanent customers.

DISTRIBUTION OF NOTIONS

Heretofore many notion items were distributed among the Dry Goods Store and the Canteen. Some of these items will now be concentrated and sold through one outlet. The

Dry Goods Store will carry combs, hair pins, hairnets, and bobby pins. Store # 1 (Rec. #19) will handle sun glasses, dust goggles, nipples and baby bottles. The Shoe Department will carry shoe laces and polish.

PHOTO STUDIO OPENING

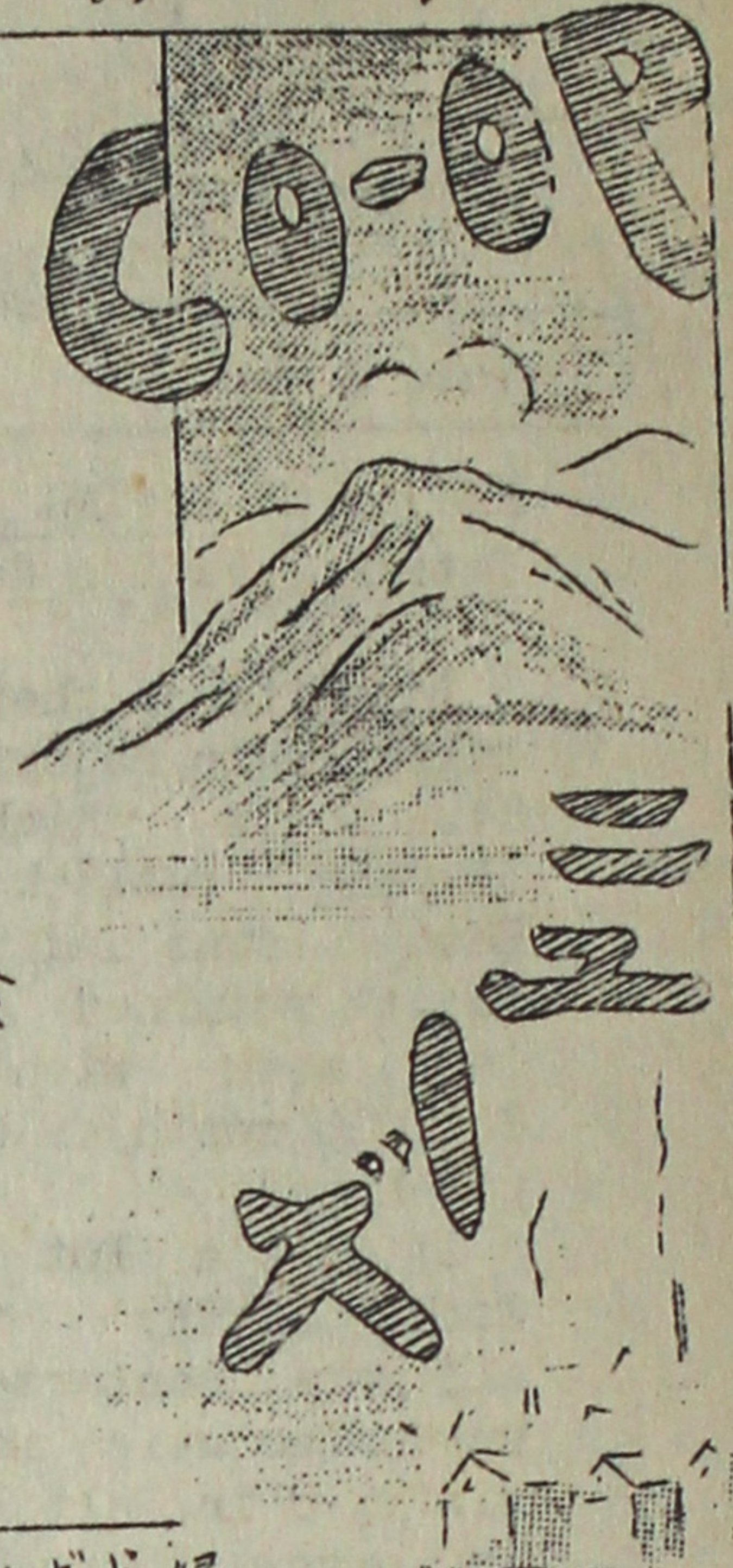
Space has been allocated in 2 - 5 - C for the Co-op Photo Studio. Work is progressing this week to improvise lighting and to get other equipment made and installed.
