TRANSFEREES TO RECEIVE REBATES AT SAME TIME AS OTHER MEMBERS

At the Cooperative Congress meeting held Tuesday night at Dining Hall 32, it was decided that no changes will be made in the policy announced last March, when the Capital Loan drive was launched, that no cash rebate would be paid for at least 3 quarters or until all of the short term capital loans had been repaid.

At the same time it was agreed that when surplus capital is available to redeem rebate equity certificates, they will be paid in chronological order. In other words, all of the first quarter rebate will be paid before any of those for the second quarter are paid, and so forth.

Those members who relocate or who transfer to other centers are requested to leave forwarding addresses at the Co-op office (Post Cards for this purpose are available at Rec 26) so that their rebate checks can be mailed to them.

However, it was emphasized that prior to their departure, all persons leaving the center can receive refunds on their membership certificates and capital loans with interest to date, if they will bring their certificates to the Co-op office

WPB RULE CUTS DELIVERIES OF SALT LAKE TRIBUNE

The Circulation Dept. received word from the Salt Lake Tribune office that newspapers can be supplied only to regular daily subscribers in accordance with orders of the WPB in Washington.

As the supply of papers has been cut, deliveries cannot be made to those who subscribe only to the Sunday paper. Also, no papers will be sold at the Canteen and no new subscriptions will be taken.

POLICY ON EXCHANGE OF DRY GOODS STATED

The Dry Goods Division will appreciate it if the patrons kindly observe the following policy which will be put into effect immediately:

1. For sanitary reasons, underwear--which includes ladies' and girls' panties or vests and men's and boys' shorts or uppers--cannot be exchanged. Ladies' slips will not come under the above category. Other items that cannot be exchanged are goods purchased and partly used or soiled at home, wool yarns, and yardage goods which have been cut from the bolts.

2. If there are any duplications in the receipt of gifts, the patrons may bring the gift (except as stated above) in for exchange.

3. All exchanges must have the approval of the store manager and the floor supervisor.
