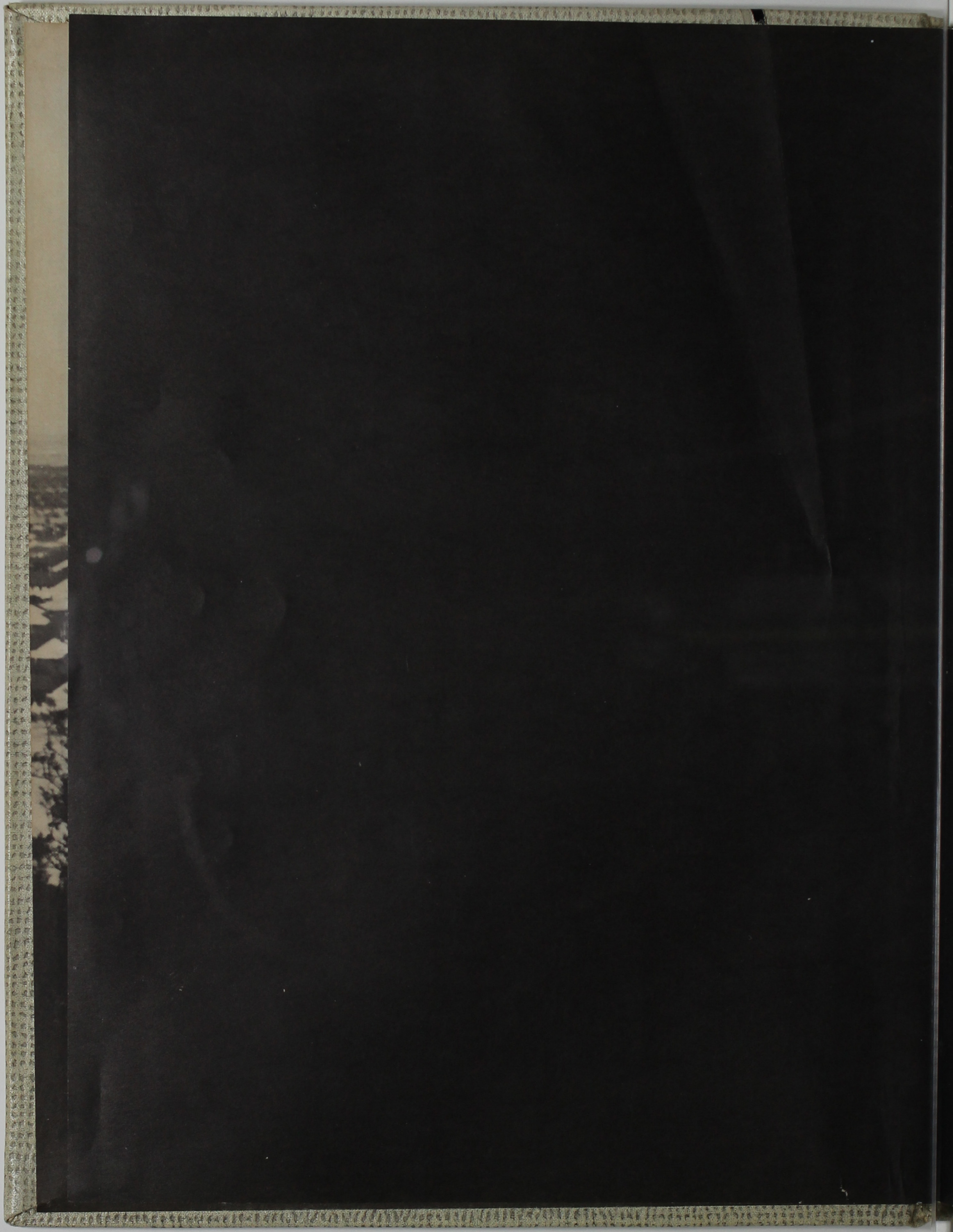

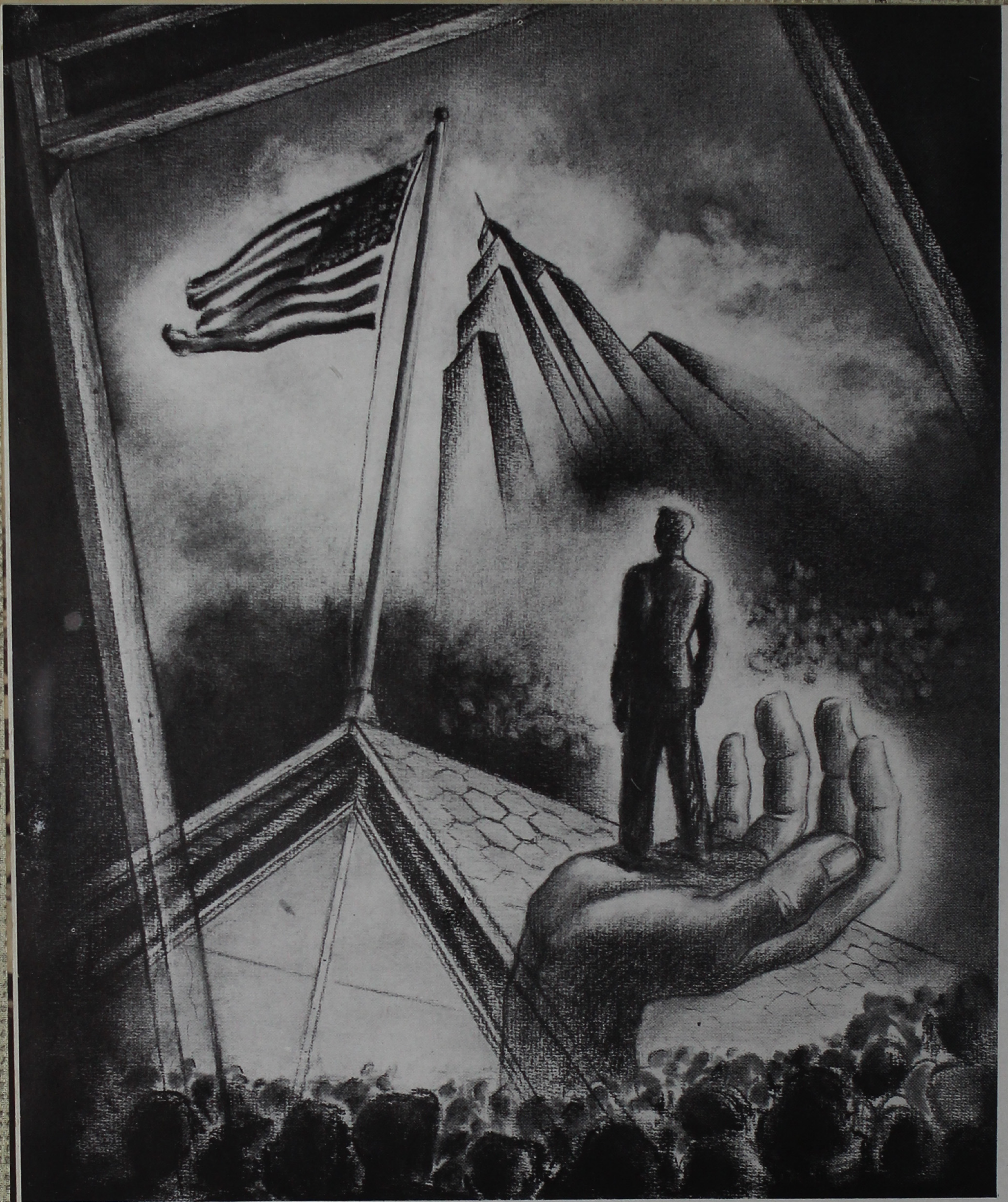
Foreword

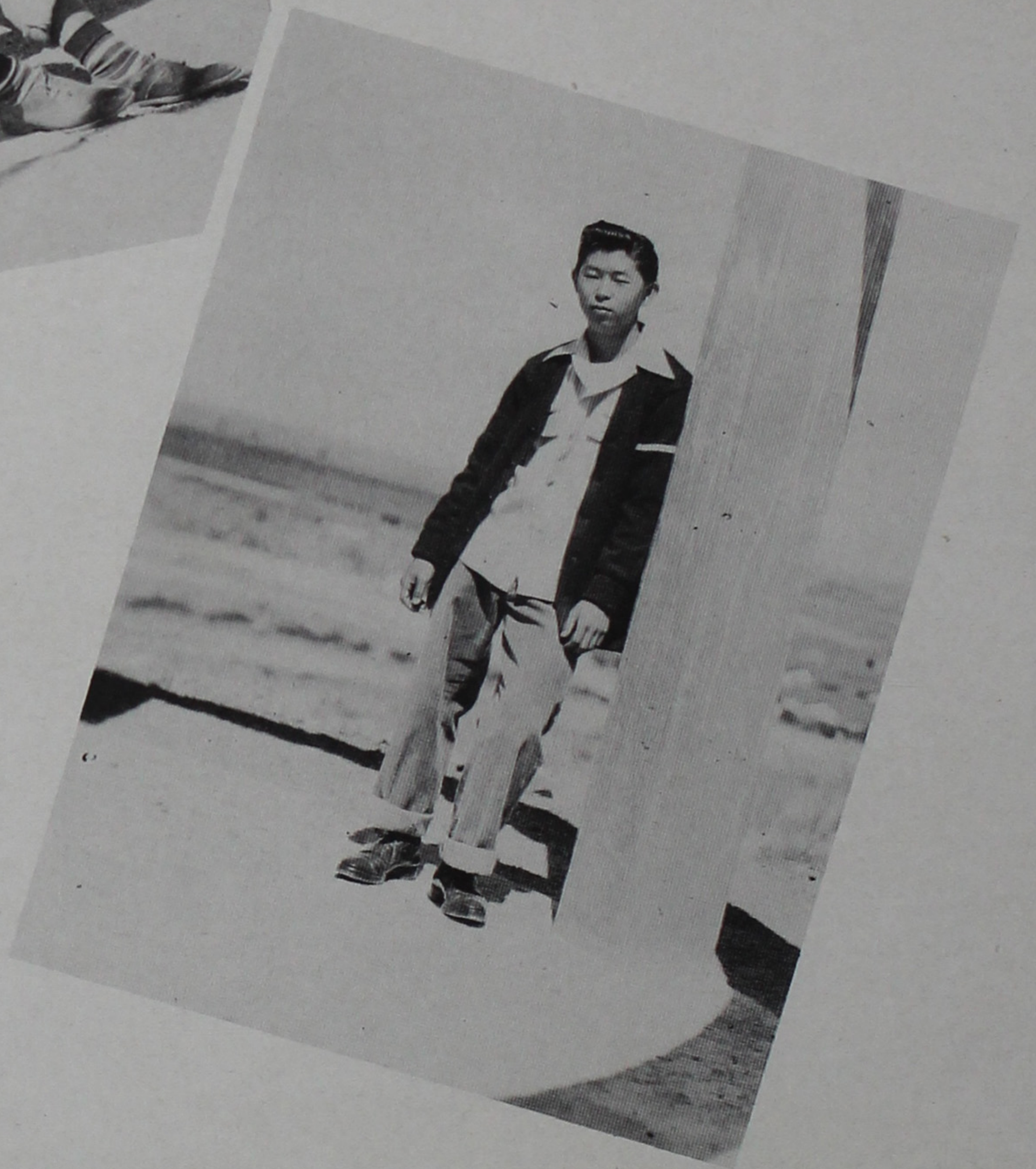
Juniors

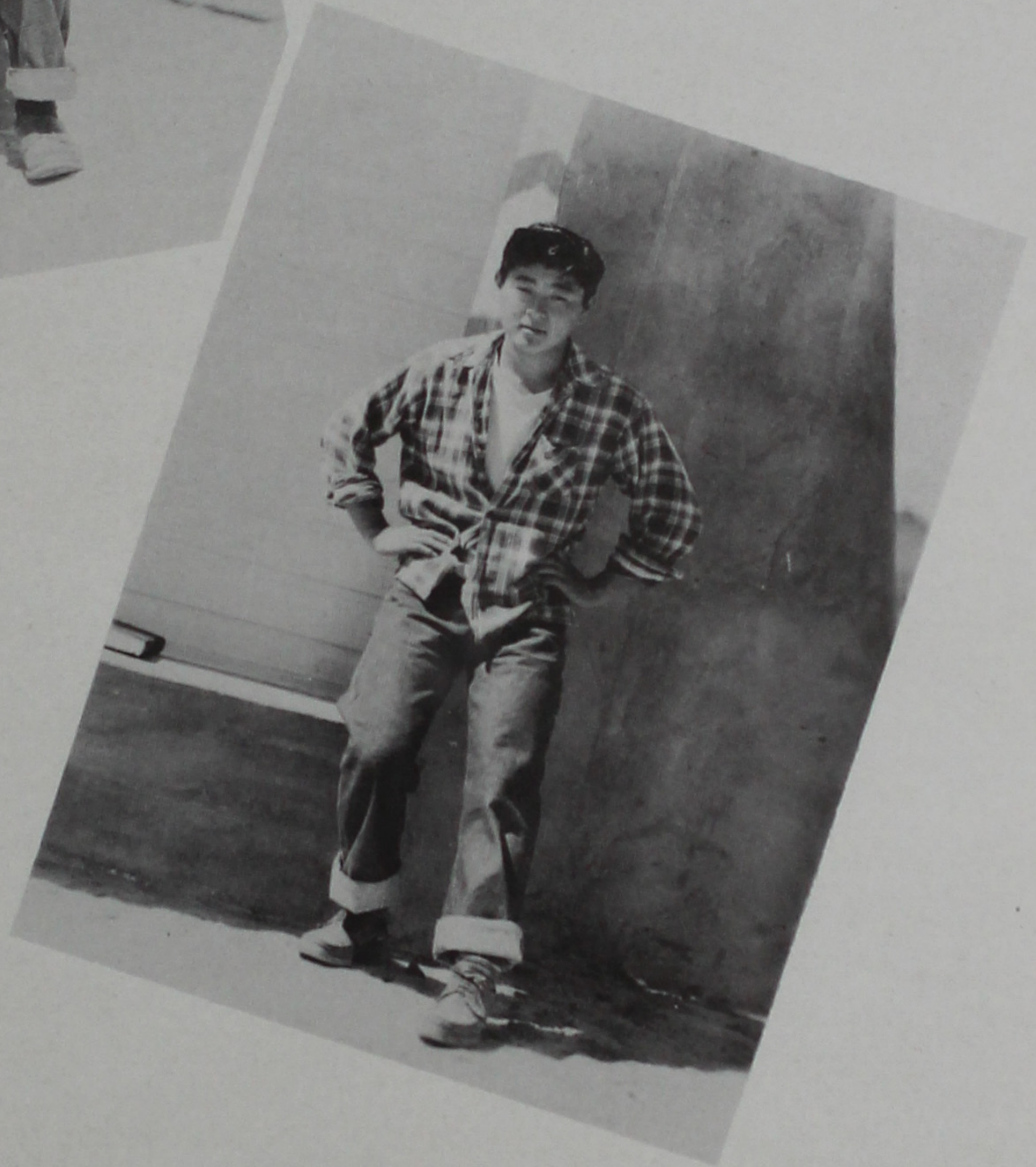
Sophomores

"MAESTROS"

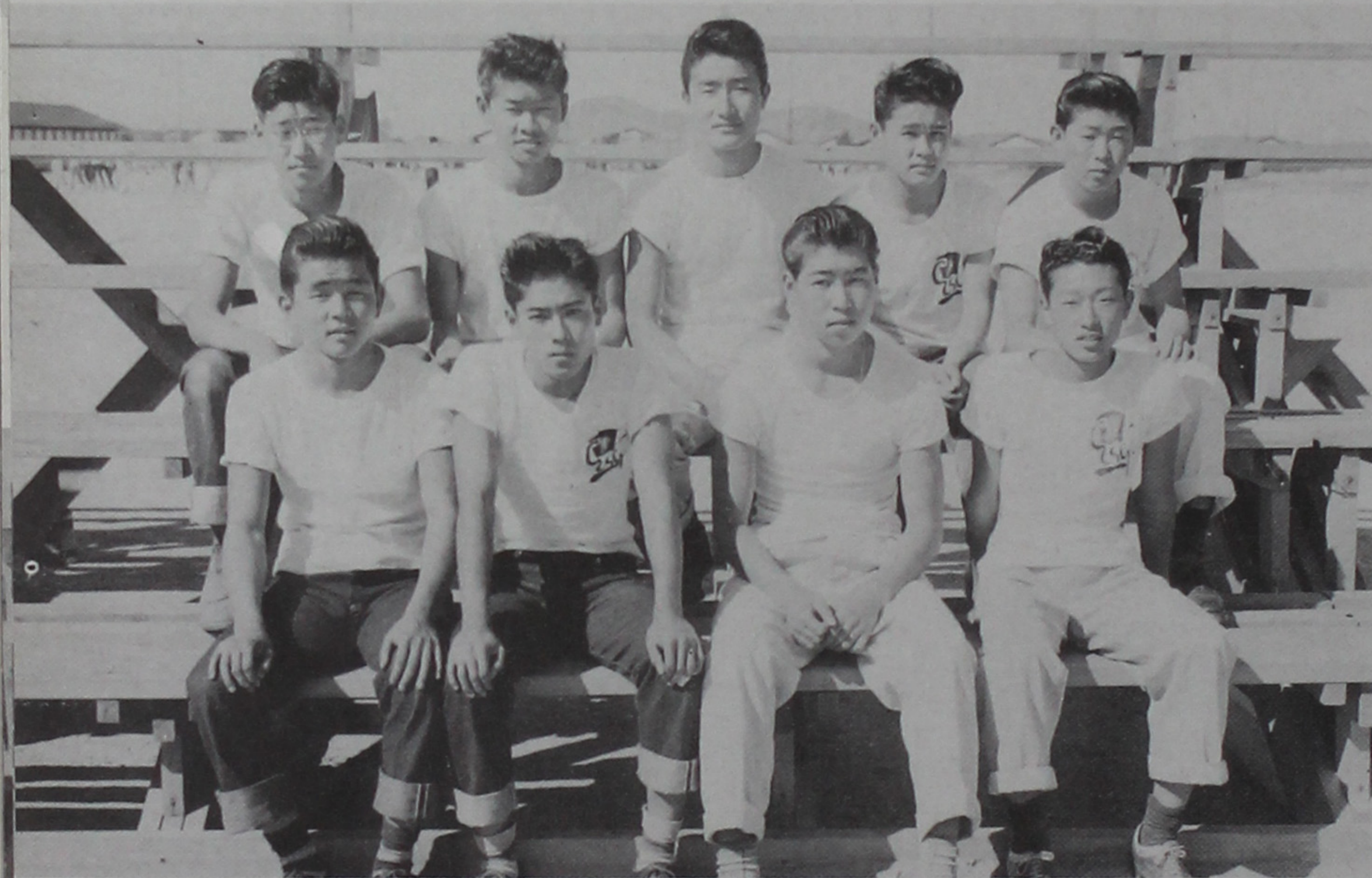
