Interned Enemy Alien.

O R D E R

It appearing that the above-named enemy alien was interned by order of the Commanding General, **U. S. Army Forces in the Central Pacific Area (formerly Hawaiian Department)**; that he was sent to the United States for internment; that the Commanding General, after reconsideration, has recommended that the internee be released from internment upon the condition that he be excluded from the Territory of **Hawaii** for the duration of the War; that the Director, Alien Enemy Control Unit, Department of Justice, Washington, D. C., concurred in the recommendation of the parole of the internee; and that the internee should be paroled; NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS ORDERED that said order of internment be, and the same hereby is vacated and set aside; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that this enemy alien be paroled under the general supervision of the Immigration and Naturalization Service; that such parole be accomplished in the same manner as paroles for those interned by the Department of Justice; that the parole is conditioned upon the execution of and compliance with the sponsor and parolee's agreement provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service; that it is made a condition of the parole that the internee not return to the Territory of **Hawaii** prior to the termination of the war; that the parole under any other conditions or the release of this enemy alien will be effected only by order of a competent representative of the War Department; that the War Department may revoke this parole upon its own initiative and will also revoke this parole upon the recommendation of the Department of Justice.

ORDER

It appears that the above-named enemy alien was interned by order of the Commanding General, U. S. Army Forces in the Central Pacific Area (formerly Hawaiian Department); that he was sent to the United States for internment; that the Commanding General, after recommendation, has recommended that the internee be released from internment upon the condition that he be excluded from the Territory of Hawaii for the duration of the War; that the Director, Alien Enemy Control Unit, Department of Justice, Washington, D. C., concurred in the recommendation of the parole of the internee; and that the internee should be paroled; NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS ORDERED that said order of internment be, and the same hereby is vacated and set aside; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that this enemy alien be paroled under the general supervision of the Immigration and Naturalization Service; that such parole be accomplished in the same manner as paroles for those interned by the Department of Justice; that the parole is conditioned upon the execution of and compliance with the sponsor and parolee's agreement provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service; that it is made a condition of the parole that the internee not return to the Territory of Hawaii prior to the termination of the War; that the parolee under any other conditions or the release of this enemy alien will be entered only upon the release of a competent representative of the War Department; that the War Department may revoke this parole upon its own initiative and also revoke this parole upon the recommendation of the Department of Justice.
