SYNOPSIS OF REVENUE LAWS, COVERING COLLECTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX						TAX				
<p>PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES become due and payable on and after February 15th of each year. ONE-HALF of taxes (WHERE THE AMOUNT IS \$10.00 OR MORE), may be paid on or before May 31st, and the other half on or before November 30th without interest charge. PROVIDED, that when one-half the taxes on personal property be not paid on or before said 31st of May, then the whole amount of such taxes shall become delinquent and interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum shall be charged upon such taxes from said date until paid.</p> <p>3% rebate allowed on personal property tax if paid in full and in one payment on or before March 15th.</p> <p>After taxes become delinquent, the County Treasurer shall prepare papers in distraint and shall without notice or demand, distraint sufficient goods and chattels belonging to the person charged with such taxes to pay the same, with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum from date of delinquency, together with all accruing costs. PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES are a lien upon all real and personal property of the person assessed, from date of assessment until paid, and in addition are a lien on the specific property assessed in the hands of a third party, and if not paid on or before date of delinquency, the property so assessed becomes subject to distraint and sale as provided by law: Sec. 86, Chap. 30, Session Laws of 1935.

It shall be unlawful for any person to remove from the state, or sell at public auction, any property assessed, until taxes and interest are paid, or until notice has been given to the County Treasurer of such removal or sale. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

The County Treasurer is without discretion to extend the time for payment of personal property taxes to any taxpayer. 162 Wash. 107.
