



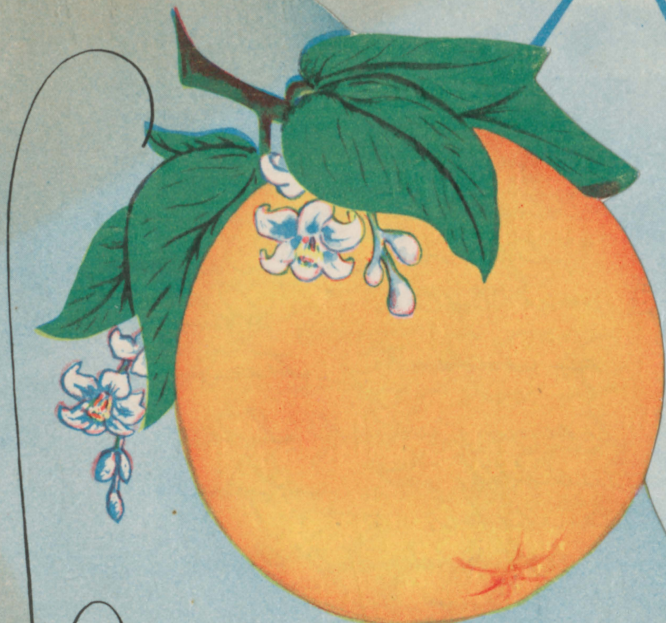



Dear Nisa

Today, finally I have time to write few of letters to write about our new Infantry life at Camp Blanding. Well, I have been here already ten days, but I had only few ~~time~~ hour to do our personal affair, because there isn't any times left over after we finish our training and also clean our life. At here, we are going to get the 17th weeks of Infantry training and it is quite different from the Infantry training which I received when I come in the Army before the War broke out. It is more tough and pretty rugged and more efficient than before.

When we left Camp Grant it was pretty cold and everybody hated to see us ^{leave} Camp Grant, and also, we hated to leave Camp Grant. After the 2 days and 2 night we arrived here, the weather, here, was so warm, and everybody went to the lake for swimming. It is pretty lucky, here, that this Camp has large lake which is almost 2 miles in diameter, right in the Camp, and it is also clear water and we could go there anytime after our duty hour.

As we think, between the 2 Camps, Camp Grant and, here, Blanding, it is entirely different in the system, and the facility. Camp Grant is superior at everything to this Blanding, they have the nice barrack, nice food, great City is nearest to Grant, soft job, but over here is really mans Army, the barrack is small and the food is not so satisfactory. The time we get up in the morning, 6 o'clock to ten o'clock in the night, there is only about a hour which we could rest and do our own things. Saturday is only a half day so here I am writing and also Sunday is our free day and we come to sleep, but it is sad when you have to pull K.P. on Saturday or Sunday. In the Camp Grant, ~~at~~ above Capt. have not do any K.P. work but over here we are in training all the non commission officer have to do K.P. as well as priv. The place is sandy allway around in the Camp, so we must keep our rifle clean as possible free from sand. If our rifle is dirty, it is very serious and they give us extra K.P. or fatigue work for that. Oh, by the way this is all rise in

Battarian, and I knew lots of the rise soldiers whom from some place I ~~it~~ came from. Lots of them from Newcastle Peoples Loomis

We have pretty nice Company Commander
and the officers, they treat us very well.
So we cooperate with them
to me we are doing pretty well
From the next week, we have to go long
range hike such as 15, 20, 25, ^{mile} ^{hike}
with the equipment which weigh about
35^{lb}. We going to hit the pretty dirty
trail and marching along.

I think during this ten days I lost
6, 7, lb already and the my face is
black under the tropical sun.

In the Camp we see lots of Palm
trees and the Pine trees all over the Camp.
After we get used to this Camp it will be
pretty comfortable place, but not now it
is just like ~~hell~~ in the hell now.

Well we ~~are~~ so far apart from the
west and only thing ^{think forward}
is a letter from home ^{go to see}
writter sometimes if you
seems that about all we ^{can}
did at ^{so} I will close this ^{letter}
now. Good bye Your friend Sumner

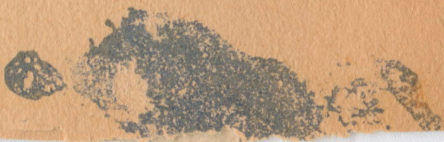
