

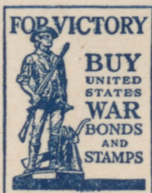
Dear Mr. Domoto:

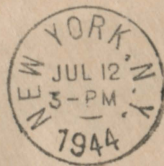
