I just received a letter from the Borgenicht Gallery---from Lois Borgenicht, Grace's daughter (maybe Mama has retired) that a Donald Goodall from the Univ. of Texas will be in N.Y. in Sept. and would like to see the Burlin paintings at Peekskill. Would you have the time to take him there? And please charge for your professional time. Mr. Goodall wants

to write a book on Paul Burlin.

It is now Sept. 28th, and I have procrastinated three weeks finishing this letter because I don't like to bother you, and I know that going up to Peekskill is a full day of your time. So please at the very least send a bill to me for your services.
