Santa Barbara. I thought it was a small community but it apparently is growing like a number of other

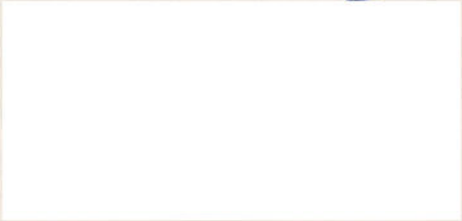
towns in this area. It is
