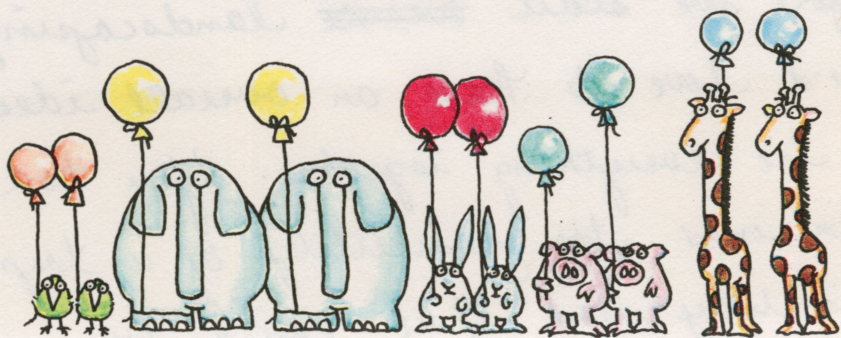




Dear Kan,

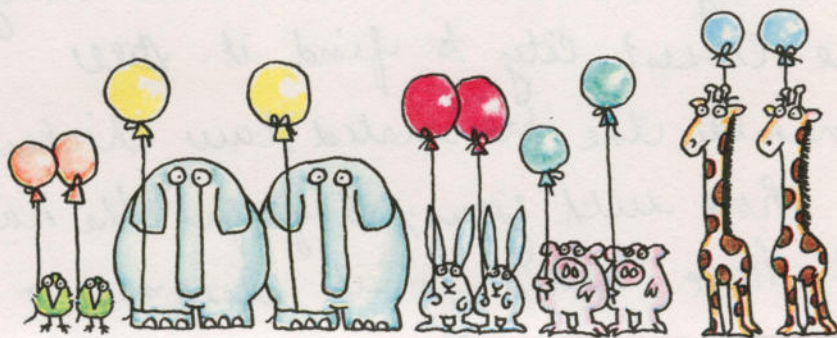
