

December 9, 1943.

Dear Kan,

I arrived back on Sunday and went to work that afternoon as the camellias were starting to flower rather heavy. Had a couple of little snow flurries, but otherwise the weather has been ideal. The ground has not frozen yet, and the landscape men are still planting. I haven't seen Mo yet, but had a letter from him when I got back here asking if the camellias could be grown outside. I presume that he is still busy with his outside work.

I wrote to the Evergreen Cemetery last week as there was no letter here in regard to the extra lots, but as yet have not received a reply. Under the circumstances I believe it best to go ahead with our plans as tentatively decided. That is the use of the marker until such a time as we can erect a larger memorial or some other plan which might be thought of after the duration.

If you will send the necessary data of births and deaths and names, I'll fill out this contract for the marker.

Under separate cover I am mailing the photos of Pa. There are one dozen. I am sending a copy of one to Mr. Senda along with Marilyn's. and one to the Okamotos. These two are the only ones to whom I'll be sending them so that there will be no duplication.

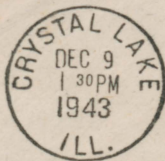
I received a note from Sorensens and a card for some flowers that were sent by Art and Mrs. Navlet. Letter of thanks has been mailed to them.
