We had an awfull thunder, lightning and rain storm last night. Damp now.

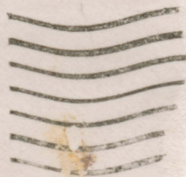
You know I gave Mr. Shilings wrong instructions on the Chicago El. I got to finish this letter and write him a letter of apology.
