Its pretty hard to say just about when you will hit some of the different places. Besides when you are at a friends place you don't excuse yourself to write letters.... they want to know what is going on and since I'm their guest, I should and can talk to them of the places and people.

You know when you arrive at a town, you have to be thinking quite a bit to see as many people, or talk to them, as possible within the shortest time. Especially if you travel around in a St. Car. It's no fun. I do a lot of walking around town.

I'm leaving for New York this morning at 8:45 AM. Stopping at Jackson to go to Lansing. Probably be in Anne Arbor for tonight. Will probably be in N.Y. Sat or Sun. depending on the train going through Syracuse or not.
