Its quite a distance down and also up. Its very well landscaped. Rindge was telling me about a house in Hackensack, N.J. I'm going to look into it. There is another draftsman who lives in Brooklyn. He invited me to his place this Sunday. We are going on a ride. He is going to show me around Brooklyn and possibility of finding a house for rent or sale. Another boy who lives on Staten Island said that he had several real Estate men looking for houses to rent or for sale too. I'm going out to Mt. Vernon again this Saturday. Probably I'll go early and then if things aren't just right, I'll go to N.J. to look into Hackensack.

I'm really enjoying my work. I don't get to design as much as I would want to but its funny how I enjoy drafting now. You ought to see my drawings really! I wouldn't have known them. Battling out ideas are fun at least when you get a few in. Its what makes things interesting.

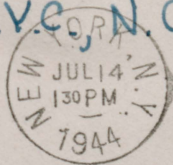
