Well, I didn't think it was fair to him or the applicant if I kept them waiting and then took another job. I didn't want to seem like running

out on him. I had some talk with
him too. He wasn't very successful
in his mission to Arizona. to recruit
fellows to work in Maryland. He wanted
to know what I thought of it. Well, there
was many reasons which I told him but
I didn't tell him the real reason - Him.

He didn't get into the Co. which he had in mind because the Employment officer didn't recommend the Company's policy. He is studying on his own. He made quite an impression on the Simons.

If you don't hear from me in the next couple of days, I'm out in the country. But don't worry because I'll write as soon as possible.
