I should be writing this letter from Hayward this morning as I had planned to leave here on a short visit on Wednesday. However the trip was cancelled for a while due to Pete's draft status. He had been called for medical ex, passed and classified 1a, but now has an application for deferment in, and the fact that I was still away may help him get this deferment.

My intentions were to get back in time to mark the tree peony seedlings and then come back here for transplanting of camellias etc and then take the family back in Aug. or September before the fall season started, but now everything is up in the air pending notice from Pete. Will let you know more later.

In regard to the \$1,000, I have entered it as cost of "Relocating Nursery" - (looking for suitable place) ~~to cost of~~ move the nursery - this was of course before we had notice that we could return to Calif. you can enter it as professional fees, and from it deduct whatever you want as traveling expenses.
