

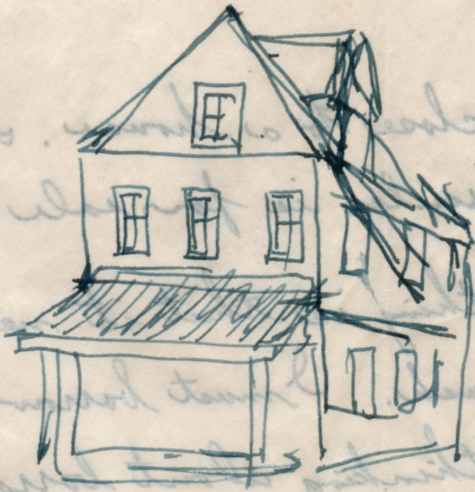
Sept. 7, 1944

I'm getting the picture prints will be ready by Friday. More film too.

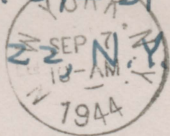
