Well you don't need to worry about me looking at the wrong time. as we learn fast over here. and all want to get back in one piece if possible. and like you said. Long Island is the place for me too.

Well travel is educational, we learned a lot and saw many interesting places. Started in Casablanca and traveled across Africa to Tunis.
