"The Golden Gate International Exposition" "Pageant of the Pacific"


• In the center of San Francisco Bay stands the largest man-made Island ever built. U. S. Army engineers, at a cost of approximately \$4,000,000 pumped sand from the Bay floor and sluiced it through pipe lines from a depth of 2 to 26 feet below water to form a rectangle 5,520 feet long and 3,400 feet wide, 13 feet above the tides.

This is TREASURE ISLAND, the site of San Francisco's World's Fair.

It is estimated that \$50,000,000 was spent for construction at the Fair. The buildings, for the most part, are of temporary construction, and Treasure Island will survive after the Fair as an Airport. It is a common sight now to see the huge China clipper ships taking off and landing. Treasure Island is the base for these planes.
