

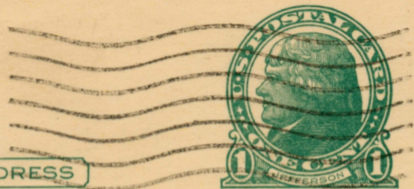
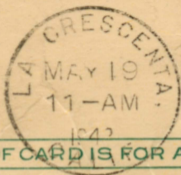
Dear Sam
