I guess you heard from one of the kids that Andy came to visit us - as a matter of fact he's been here a second time (more about this later) - apparently likes to come out here though it takes almost two hours to come here from Brooklyn.

He's really a very nice sort of person - very tall - looks soon like Dan - quite intelligent and not noisy like college boys are apt to be. I was surprised to see such a product - esp. when I thought of obama - can. - But he's really alright.

I asked him about his plans for his mother since the camps are closing - he finishes school in May & apparently has good leads to jobs through the school - so he'll look for an apartment & then care for his mother.
