Dear Kicie - The package from home came as an unexpected surprise -

I'm sorry - so let them know we got the stuff & thanks to everyone.

when he's around - If Louise ever asks me to keep an eye on him  
I will simply have to refuse. He's worse than any child I know -  
it's all her fault because she's so darned tame but just the same
