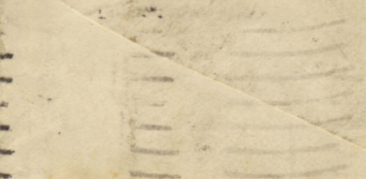


Dear Kan:
