I'll help her.

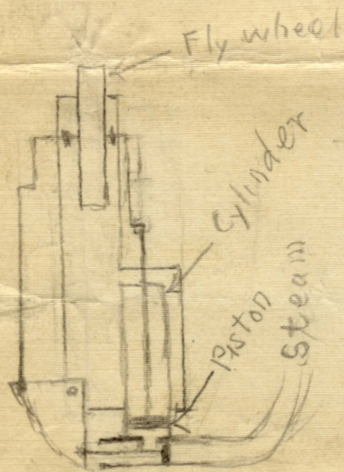
The school band
