How are you. I am pretty good but I e got acold. I was sick in bed about three day. and Wak and Tok were also.

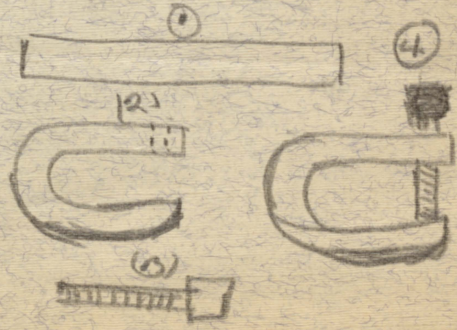
