be bought - I've also bought material for  
clothes etc. - Hell, it costs some money to  
live - even in camp. - By the way - just  
how much do you have anyway? I don't know  
how you feel about it but I have my doubts  
about getting a H.O.L.P. (whatever that means)  
okay if you put a \$100 cash down on the  
house - it's not very much - maybe I don't  
sound very encouraging - well, I don't feel

very very happy about anything - except  
that your camera is in my hands now - it  
came Friday.

(Thursday)  
The Tanihawas are leaving next week - I really  
feel very badly about it - primarily because  
it's going to be awfully hard on Mili +  
Kareo - both are very attached to the kids  
as well as Mrs. Tanihawa. This is esp. hard on  
Mili because she's had to say good bye to  
so many people & this time there won't be anyone left  
for her to play with - she cries & cries when  
the 2 girls left in a car to go to Kamae not  
so long ago - he was afraid they weren't going  
to come back again like so many who've said  
good bye to her. - Psychologically it's very bad -  
esp. because she's so so sensitive. About her  
speech - I have to have free time with her or  
she by constant coaching she can get so she  
can say a lot of things I've tried & learn it

but don't have the time nor the energy right now -  
Bedtime is the best time - she wants to be  
read to or look at catalogues & name things  
but K III is usually bouncing around & yelling  
for attention so I can't do it - Both kids take  
fairly long naps in the aft. so they're up  
awake about 8:30 or 9:00 so I have to get them  
to sleep - as soon as we get out it'll be easier  
cause they should be one for each of them & then  
we can help Mimi - she really wants to talk  
awfully badly & tries so hard, it's a shame.

Tuesday note -

Sorry I didn't get this off sooner - it's been so  
darned hot it's not even funny - the kids aren't  
eating any well because of the heat & are consequently  
awfully cranky - K III has shoes finally -  
took 3 weeks for them to come from Denver - &  
those that were bought for me were too small -  
now the kid is really beginning to walk  
& he certainly is a handful - I don't get a

thing outside the usual routine done any  
more. He's real cute but what a boy - I think  
you're really going to be amazed at his size &  
energy. He fell off of my bed today -  
first time - & did he scream - God - we  
sure need a wooden floor soon.

Boy, I sure have my ups & downs - I'm just  
getting too tired & stressed - living in this  
"strung up in midair" fashion for nearly 7  
months is wearing me down - & then again  
it's too damned hot - I get so lonely  
& tired that even crying doesn't help -  
If I don't write sometimes it causes it  
better that I don't - otherwise you'd probably  
get real mad or be real hurt at the things  
I'd say.

Well, tomorrow is August 2nd & our  
anniversary - things have happened since  
our relationship - right now all I want  
home is to have you hold me real close -

it's been so long since you left.

August 3rd

Your letter about the pictures came yesterday -  
nice seeing you again. - Thanks a lot.

See, this letter go off - it's still hot as  
blazes - a pretty uncomfortable to say the  
least. It's 12:00 right now but sorry I'm  
perspiring as I write this - it's the first night  
that it's been as hot as this - India is just  
drizzling wet - same with Kanzo - the fans  
on yet too.

Yuni's Waki freight left my hands just  
yesterday - boy, are they going to be furious  
esp. since they sent their request by airmail.  
They (Properties) took the stuff down to the  
warehouse to be weighed & the fellows said it  
may leave for Boston by the end of the week  
& maybe not. Mr. Fisher (Prop. head)  
told me the stuff would take from 2 weeks to

2 months to get there - more likely 2 months.

Bay - I wrote to old Wah about this - she's going to be awfully mad. - she will.

As soon as you decide on a place - I'm going to send as much freight as possible right away in your name so that maybe by the time I get there it'll be there - at least I won't have to wait so long.

It was alright of your brother - I'd have been real disappointed if he'd said no - please honey, borrow enough to keep us going for a while - there are so many essentials that we're going to have to buy - like a stove, K III's bed, comb, some chairs - dishes, ~~pan~~ pans, etc. etc. - just real essentials.

about your clothes - I guess (rather know) you'd better buy a suit - what you have here isn't much - I'll send you the rayon

shirt - you have ~~some~~<sup>2</sup> cotton short sleeved  
ones (g-3) - if you want to wear them on  
weekends in the evenings I'll send them too.

hopeless) - it looks okay - a little worn  
in spots but wearable - you could get a pair  
of pants to match it - shall I send it out?  
your other clothes are no good - except your  
black suit which I also had cleaned - you  
really need some clothes. How are your socks?  
Full of holes? - not necessarily from wear  
but your 24 or 48 hour soakings - Sads!

The Taniharas will be leaving in about 4 days &  
I really feel awful everytime I think about it -  
Poor Mike. I don't have anything to give  
them so will donate the box of candy you  
sent not so long ago - I wasn't sure if that  
was for me or for them - it came in good

condition this time. Josh I certainly owe  
them a lot for all they've done - will just have to  
make it a pt. to remember them on Christmas.

Did you know Leo Kikuchi? He was killed in  
the Melanesian area.

Are Iris + Paul going back to Berkeley or what?  
Well - about the dues - if Iris would only  
remember that I sent her a dollar for  
postage to send the damn thing to me - she  
didn't have to eat it around with her.

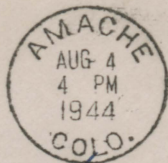
Well - I'd better close a mail this off in the
