Wed. May 13 1942

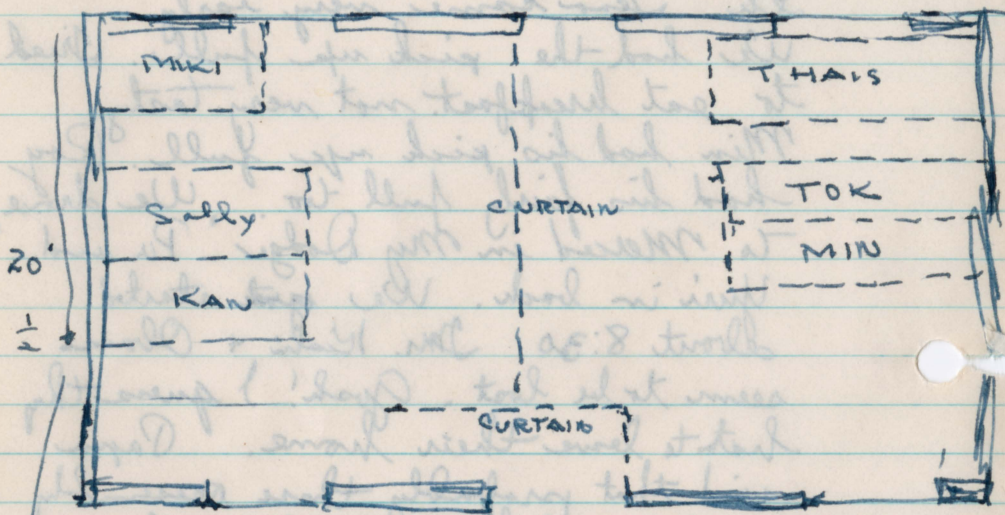
We worked all night and fell asleep from 3:30 am to 4:30 am. Went to bath and then woke Wok Yui. Started packing our blanket etc. Jim came very early. We had the pick up full. Tried to eat breakfast. not very tasty.

Min had his pick up full. Roy had his fairly full too. We drove to Merced in my Dodge. Pa and Yui in back. We ~~quite~~ started about 8:30. Mr. Kishi + Obasa seem to be lost. Gosh! I guess they hate to leave their home. Papa said that probably these assembly center will be used for refugees if the cities get bombed. We waited for quite awhile at the Veterans building. Not much need take. Just waiting for a bus. Didn't take long to get to the fair grounds. They searched our baggages and in the exhibit hall they Irish us. Saw Dr. Yamada. Sally, Boley, and I got a ride into the barracks to feed Miki. Small service.



We are in the 3rd shift for eating. After a bit a sleeping Sally, Mike and I are to go with Tok and Mike + Thais. We started to unpack. Put the curtains on the door first.

walls are 8' high studs plus 4' o.c.

No privies for ladies. Picked up a lot of tough papers to use later, lined some of the lower side wall. Made the Boly's house enclosure and arranged the drawers against the East wall. Put up the blue curtain dividing the room. Wak sewed it together. It works up pretty good.

Joichi has a baby girl weighing 6 lbs. 5  $\frac{1}{4}$  ounces.

We heat it by  $\frac{3}{4}$  ounce.

We had a lot of fun kidding him

Some ladies have about 4/6 small ones - its a hard job feeding them. Blind Bunch come over and we had tea and talked.

Fixed up the electrical fixtures

Fri May 15

Breakfast at 8:00 AM. Washed at the laundry. Breakfast was eggs and trench toast.

Towel racks, clothes lines, also a curtain for Olsson. Sally did laundry. B We have the

kerosene stove in the Belrys cubicle and it heats that space up quick. Life came and

glanced a quick glance at S.

Mary was over at Yuki's most of the morning. They

have a bamboo screen in front of door besides Paul bed. Looks ok.

Min has had a job in the office since Thurs. & Roy has a job too.

Min's plywood came in. We don't know what to do with it yet.

Saw Sam today working at the center stove. Sally & I went to Hospital to see the Dr. about Miho. He

said that it wasn't measles.

Commented on her "improvement" from the use of "Hypa-Allergic" powder milk. Made

some comment on the

lady as Tok did. We  
heard the band in the evening  
in the ball park. Takahashi  
was over and we talked for  
quite a while on plants + soils.

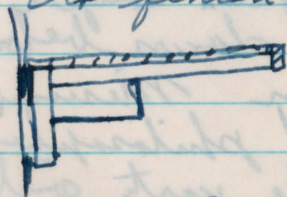
It was pretty hot all right. Confal in Waki's room. Tea and crackers etc. Roy only came over. Mr. Kishi.

too. Grand old philosopher.

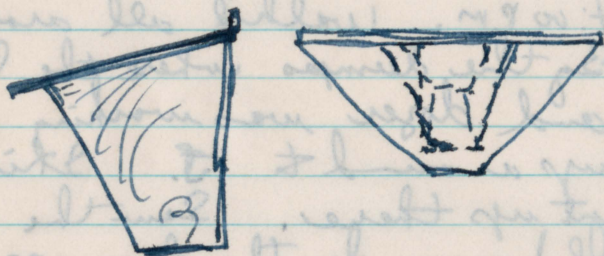
We had a little party, outdied

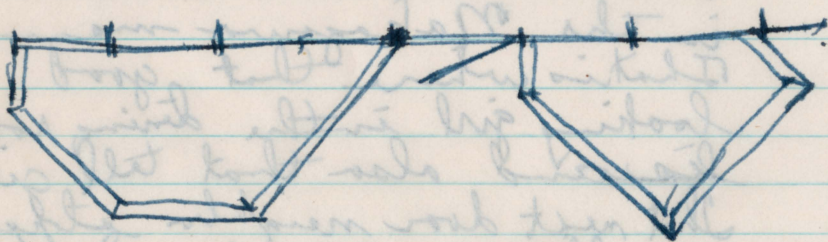

Min's shoes are very good. I think I'll get one like it next time. Turned the ground over again. I have to finish up the border with a cap.

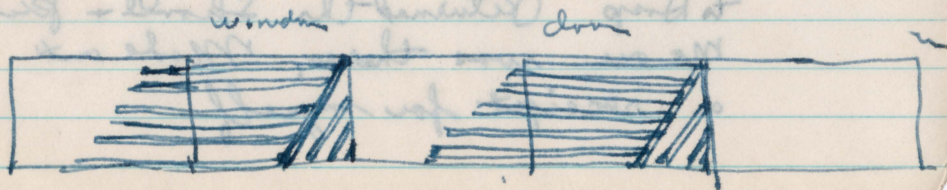
The Ward's tissues are like the Kleenex. Just good for one blow.

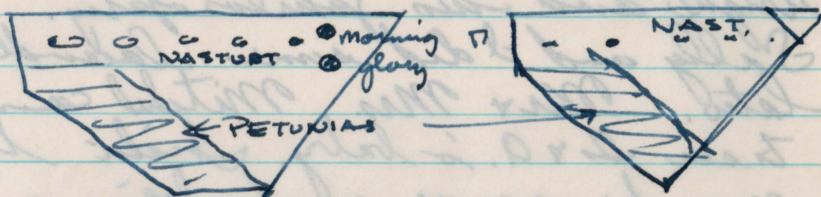

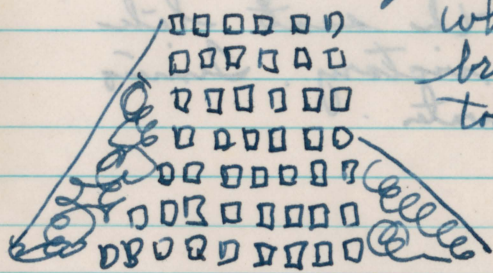

to teach in Int. Decoration.

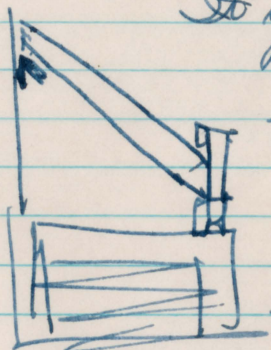

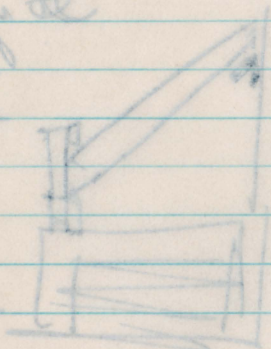

I asked Mitchell in the morning and he said OK. asked about the plywood too. I think he forgot. Alt. Sally worked on her weaving. She is doing a lot of work on it.

Nashimoto came for both plates to  
work on. I've figured out a project  
for about five of them. A Barab  
of 4 family with 6 in the family.  
basic facilities. I think they will  
like it. We will exhibit somewhere  
later. I've come to conclusion for 3 classes  
in Arch. Mr. Kishi & I went to see the

When they came over we had a interesting time discussing the possibilities. They all were interested & decided to meet at one of their member's apt at 9:00 am instead of class. I think we can get something out of them. Mas strikes me as a very good fellow, smart too. Its too bad they have an academic background. Ken & Mas borrowed my arch. Forum. I'm dividing the class into three parts. Wrote a letter to Jack & Hideo. Sam came over later & we talked for a long time. Later Yui & I went to the dance but it was too late. I wish there would be a teacher's meeting. How else can I get some ideas

Sunday June 15, 1942

I find it hard to get up. About as hard as I ever found. Everyone is home and we had a gib fest, Uah Yui, Joh, & I about Alice and how much she makes Ichii work.

Started the work for the 1st class in Arch. Stone texture.

Read something on Arch & also made some notes for Arch. class.

We were over Uoh's and chided a great deal on teaching. I told Men I need a visiting professor or I will run out of topics to teach. Tomorrow is the moving crew.

Mailed three letters out. One to ~~Bill~~ Jack Brydon, one to Hedie, out to Bill.

Monday, June 16<sup>5</sup>

Another class and I'm going to run out again. Today we met at the sun pit. More on organic arch. They all seem quite interested, I hope they understand. It's so very important. This is one time I had I grab a few notes. Gosh it still seems a long time to talk. Landscape design + Arch. I made both sign ups with drafting experience. L.D. class two girls came. 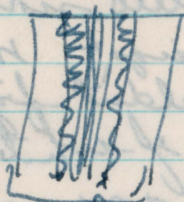
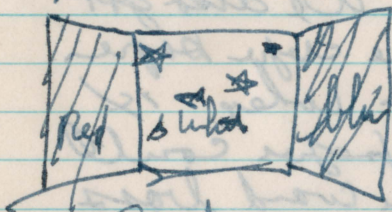

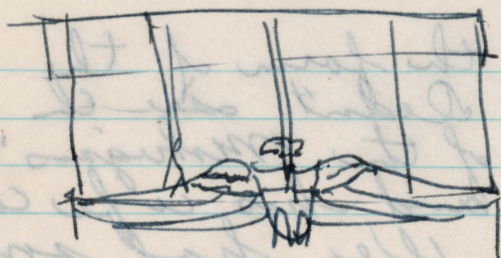

revealing on the new system. Teaching

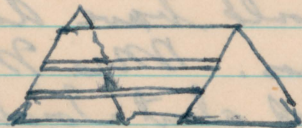
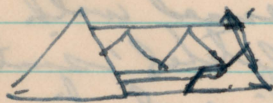
the music first and then breaking

Mr. Mitchell knows his stuff. We had two programs that didn't just go over. They weren't there. Letter from Gene. My name isn't registered, so I didn't get an absentee ballot. The program is all right though. We need a few finishing touches. Too bad we can't have another practice rehearsal. Milton showed me her new number two. As it was hot. Lots of things left out red top stuff. Platform etc. Ok. through. Artist Jussy painting signs & also stage decorations.

bad one in a way. but

Sunday. Aug 23

The artist started early and  
finished by noon



They used show card and did a  
very fine job. Looked around  
all day for someone who knew  
anything about the feed after.  
Couldn't find anyone. We had  
to get together when the show

had started. The fellows did alright too. We had to call the chefs and other people involved. We made a big mistake when George Miyama announced about the feed after. I think Charlie caused all the confusion. I couldn't find Morishita but he did turn up. The program started 15 minutes too early.

Mikio caused that. Ben started too early. Waldo starts to talk too soon should wait until applause ends more. Gosh! what I wouldn't do to have at least one rehearsal on the stage. Programs went pretty slow the first half. Sumi wasn't present and the people just didn't get on stage - no signal. Darn it!

We had reserved seats in front for performers. It didn't all work out just right. There wasn't enough juice for all our lighting effect. The Ballet was lighted pretty good though. The choruses were swell! The individual numbers were fine, but we need a snap. Speech by Buddy swell.

Wed. Sept. 2, 1942

I slept in smoker sitting up. I  
had everyone up & ready by 6:30  
but a little misunderstanding develops  
& the whole breakfast was late.

are O.K. They cleaned up the car all  
day. Did a pretty neat job too.  
Breakfast O.K. Last night post threw  
Needles & Barstun. Today we  
had two small stops to exercise  
Sam Sally & the baby both times.

The guards are O.K. Post  
Flagstaff more pines than  
anything. Stopped at Ulnish  
for water. As ran out of it.  
Talked off and on with Dr. He wants  
to get a beard. He should have one  
too. He talked of I.S.C. last convention  
& being chairman of the staff. He  
asked a few questions about the  
Doctors of Merced. O'Kenogji,  
Duke, Yamada, Fujimoto. Jack  
& I talked a bit too about travel  
etc. He had been in Chicago.  
Treated around by the four  
commissioners. Dr. & I talked  
about the Nisei too. Lunch  
& supper. O.K. Supper, creamy  
chicken soup, potatoes, rice, bread.  
Lunch stew etc. no butter  
any time. ate with Jack at Lunch.

got some lumber tonight.

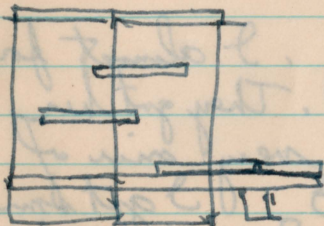
Sat. Sept 5

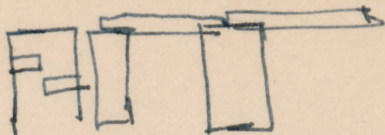

Tues. Sept. 8

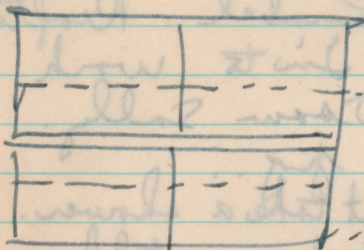
Reported at 8:00 PM. Home around.

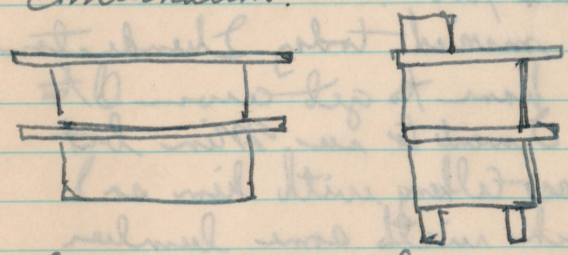

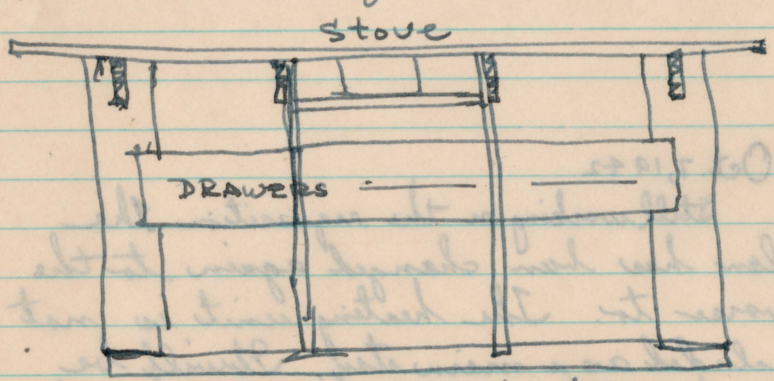
Still working on the requisition. The

now as Wak. They live next

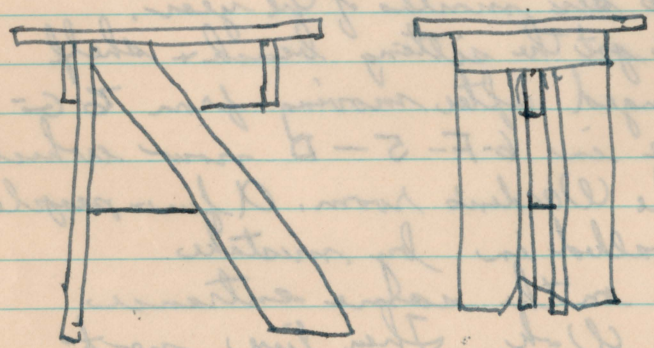
