INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING PERSONNEL SECURITY QUESTIONNAIRE, W. D., P. M. G. O.-ID FORM No. 58

W. D., P. M. G. O.-ID Form No. 58 must be prepared in sets of three copies each. All questions must be answered. If the answer is none, so state. If more space is required to answer any question on this form use the reverse side of the sheet, indicating the answer to the question by using the corresponding number. Care should be exercised to state facts correctly. Your attention is drawn to normal penalty imposed for misrepresentations.

NOTE.—Do not use the blocked space in upper right-hand corner, or the squares in left margin.

1. Insert name and address of Government establishment or agency requesting the investigation. Insert date on which form is executed.
2. Insert the name and address of the company or establishment where work is to be performed, and if a subsidiary of a larger firm so state.
3. Name title of position or a brief description of job. If classified contract, state whether confidential or secret.
4. Last name should be capitalized and first and middle names in small letters. Insert all names other than legal names by which subject is known, including nicknames.
5. State number, street, city, and State where you now reside. Example: 1733 Twentieth Street NW., Washington, D. C.
6. State the last address where you resided prior to present address.
7. Place and date of birth. If you have never secured a Social Security number, so state.
8. Name country only. If naturalized United States citizen, include certificate number.
9. Under marital status state whether single, married, divorced, separated, widow, or widower.
10. Where information is not known, so state. Under spouse name wife or husband even if separated or divorced. Include all members of family as shown in relation column.
11. Name of last school attended.
12. Under country, state the name of country in whose military service you served, such as American, Canadian, German, Italian, etc.
13. Be sure that the employment is given back to include 1935. Any periods of unemployment should be stated, giving dates of this unemployment.
14. State name of organization, character, type or kind of organization such as fraternal, social, political, religious, etc.; address of the organization and number of years you belonged to each.
15. List all countries visited. Under reasons for visit be specific such as to study, for pleasure, on business, to visit relatives, etc.
