## Dear Mrs. Agnes Tsumanna:

It was 7th day of November that I received your letter of October I4th, and I am very glad to receive it. I feel very sorry to know that I have troubled you in asking Rev. Shimizu, to translate my letters into English.

I I am well, but my eye sight is getting very weak, due to my old age,

and I can not do reading much.

2 In his school days late Mr. Tsumanuma was mischievous and I had some difficulities in controlling him as his school teacher. However, it is my strong belief that his strong will power, which was predominant even in his earlier ages made his success in his later years.

3 I am very glad to hear that you are contemplating to write an autography of your 2I years' married life. I shall think it is a most fitting tribute to your beloved husband, as he seemed to enjoy writings and literatures. I shall be very happy to get a copy

when you published it.

4 You must be very happy to think of a day when Mr.George is to be graduated from Syracuse University next year.

5 Although you are in good family, please don't work toohard. and take

good care of yourself.

6 I received copies of " History of Mr. Tsumanuma" which you sent to me and Mr. Wakao. I did not send a copy to Mt. Sojiro Tsumanuma. He died on November 15,1937. His oldest sister (Your husband's aunt) and her 3 sisters are still living, but I do not send any copy to them, because they do not understand English, and that is the reason that they do not write you.

7 Mr. Takeo Endo, married to Mr. Enami's daughter, and he is practicing

medicine in Tokyo. with you

8 I have a same feeling/in appreciating autumnal beauty. Generally young people seem to enjoy the beauties of spring and summer, butwhen people get old, they admire more of the solemnity of Autumn.

9 Please excuse me for my delay in writing this letter. As the winter

weather is approching, please take good care of yourself.
