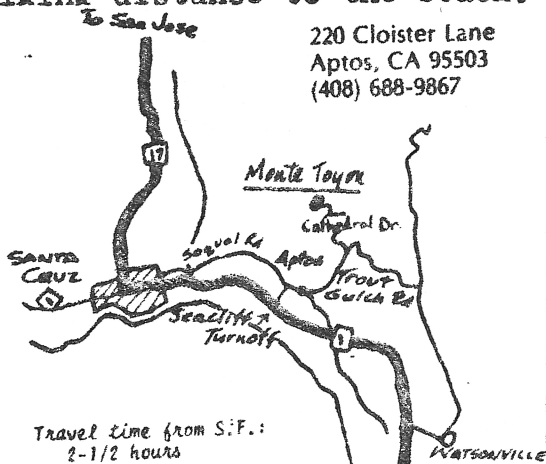

walking distance to the beach.



TO GET TO MONTE TOYON: On Highway 1, approximately 8 miles south of Santa Cruz, take the Seaclyff-Aptos exit east. Headed toward Aptos, turn right at the stop sign onto Soquel Drive. Continue through Aptos and turn left onto Trout Gulch Road, crossing over railroad tracks. After two blocks, turn left onto Cathedral Drive. 1 1/2 miles along this road will be Monte Toyon.
