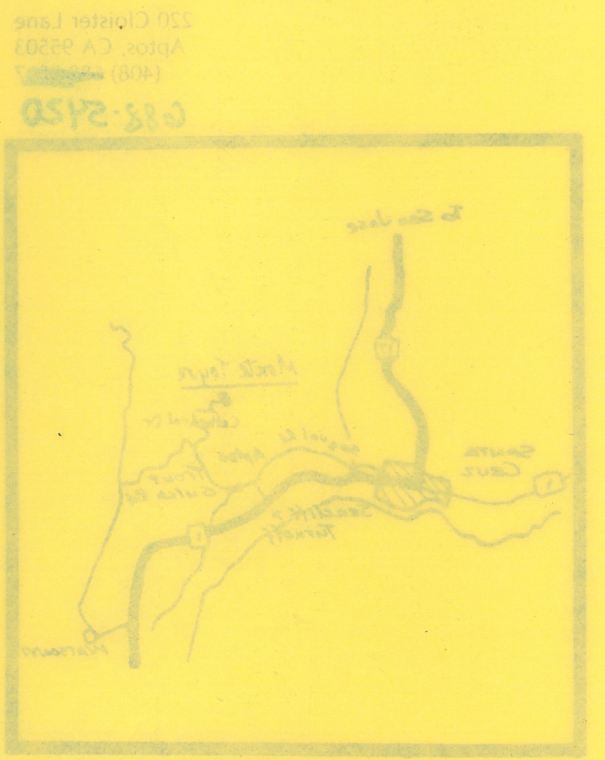

MONTA TOYON
This year LSR will be held at Monte Toyon, located in the Santa Cruz Mountains. It is 75 miles south of San Francisco and 2 1/2 miles from the Monterey Bay and the Pacific Ocean on grounds set among ageless redwoods.



TO GET TO MONTE TOYON: On Highway 1, approximately 8 miles south of Santa Cruz, take the scenic exit east. Headed toward Aptos, turn right at the stop sign onto Soudel Drive. Continue through Aptos and turn left onto Trout Creek Road, crossing over railroad tracks. After two blocks, turn left onto Cathedral Drive. 1 1/2 miles along this road will be Monte Toyon. Travel time from S.F. 2 1/2 hours.

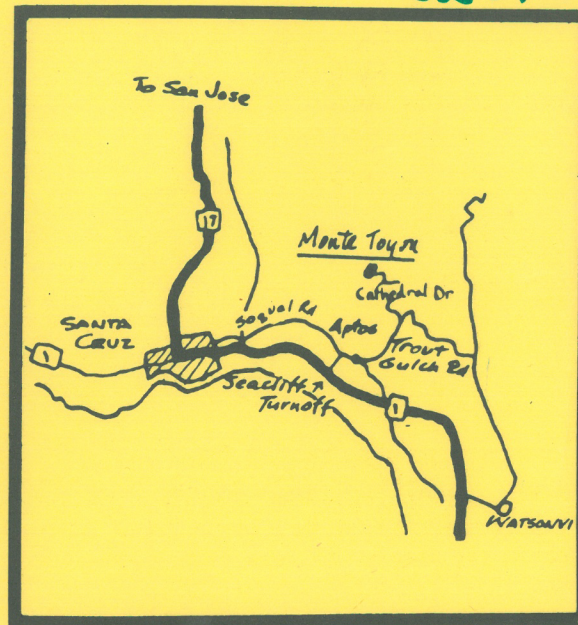
