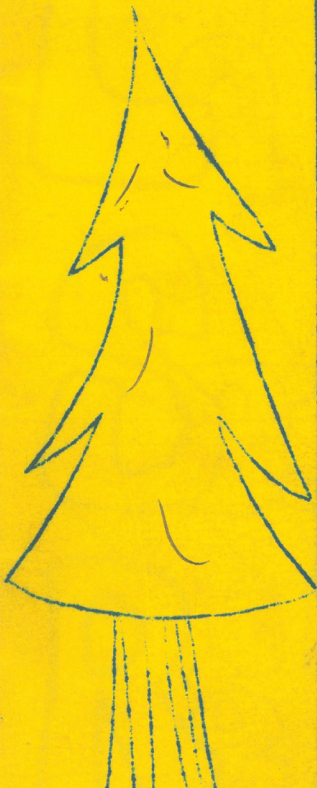

CAMP RULES

CAMPERS:

1. a. Will make full settlements for damages before leaving.

- g. No firecrackers. It is against U.S. Forestry Regulations.

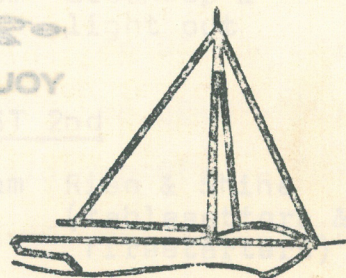
BOATING AND SWIMMING:

- d. Life jackets will be worn while boating.



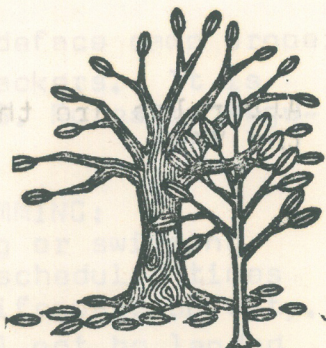
3. All decisions concerning campers who are unable to abide by the conference regulations will be brought before the camp council for dismissal from camp.

All rules are the rules of the YMCA.

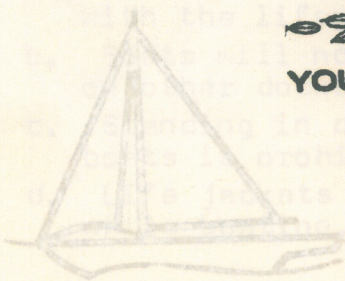

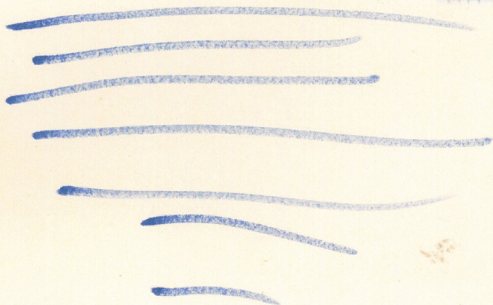

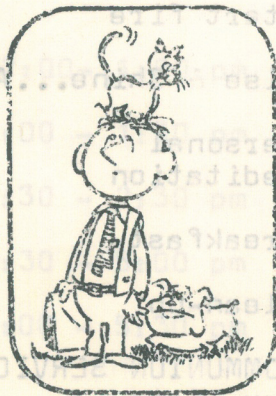
