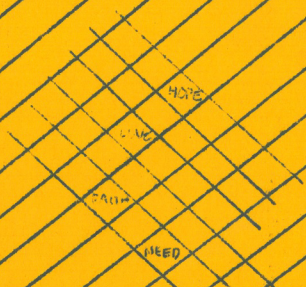

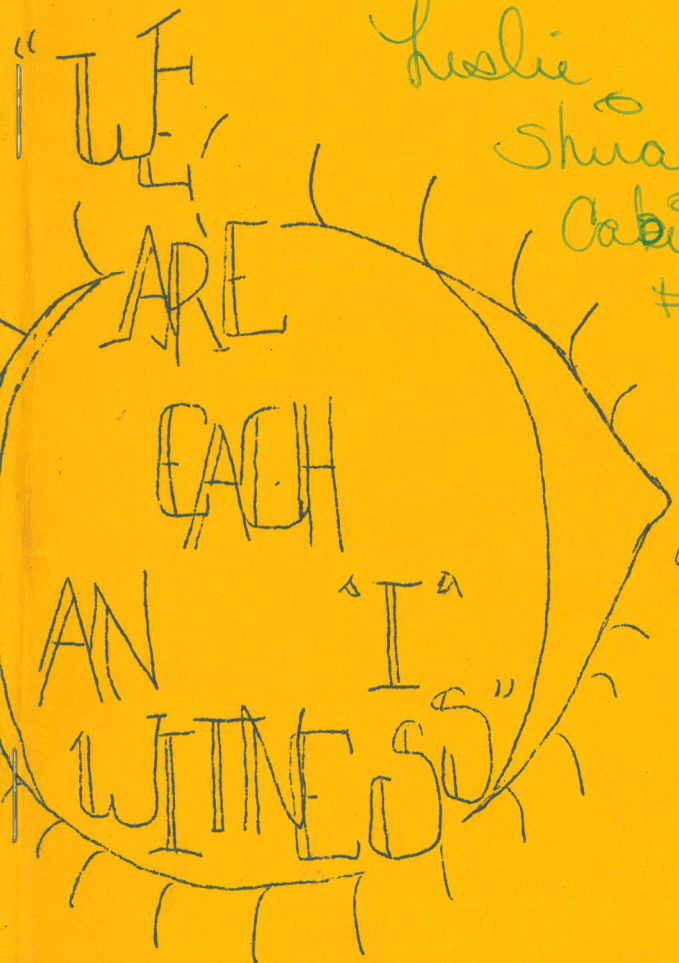

Donald H. Fado was born in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, but spent most of his childhood years in Redding, Calif.

He attended and graduated from the College of the Pacific in 1955 and the Boston University School of Theology, where he did his seminary study and graduated cum laude in 1958.

During his college years Rev. Fado served as president of the California-Nevada Conference of the Methodist Youth, assistant director of the Wesley Foundation in Amhurst, Mass. and assistant minister of the Harvard-Epworth Methodist Church in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Prior to his appointment as pastor of the First Methodist Church of Burlingame, Rev. Fado pastored the Sierra Vista Methodist Church in Fresno and the First Methodist Church in Hanford. He also attended the 1968 Lake Sequoia Retreat as our guest speaker.
