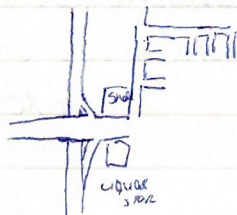

### Registration Information

Price for the entire weeks camp is \$70.00 ~~to~~ \$10.50 per day for part-time ~~3~~, and we absolutely must receive your form by postmark Aug. 6. Any forms postmarked Aug 7 or later will be returned. No forms will be accepted ~~at~~ during the week of camp itself. If, however, we receive your form by July 28, the full time price is reduced to 60.00. Part time fee ~~remains the same~~ is reduced to 8.50 per day. Send us your forms by July 28 and you'll save yourself some bucks. Make checks payable to Lake Segovia Retreat.

If you are under 18 years of age, we must have your parents →

signature. We also require that your minister read and sign the form. <sup>no matter what your age</sup> Should we receive your forms w/o the proper signatures, it will be returned and you may miss the July 28 date.

Remember, we must have your form by postmark Aug 6. No one will be allowed to attend Camp should we receive your form after that date or at camp. There are no exceptions.

### Bus Information

If you need transportation from Fresno to LSR, a bus will leave Saturday, Aug 14, at 1:30 from the Japanese Congregation Church, 806 Collins, Fresno (209-264-6735) The cost of the bus is \$5.00 round trip, or \$4.00 one way. This fee is separate from the 70.00 registration fee and must be included with your form to secure a place on the bus.

Directions to the church: Northbound on 99 → take Fresno St. Exit, turn left at top of off ramp (Fresno St), <sup>left</sup> right at 2nd lite ( Street) Right on Enyo. Pass a couple of intersections and your there. Southbound on 99 → Take Fresno Street exit, turn right at stoplite, left immediately at 1st light ( Street) Right on Enyo, a couple of intersections down and its on the right.

### General Schedule

A usual day at Camp Redwood goes like this - Wake up, Morning Watch, Breakfast & Clean up; Speaker's talk, Communication Groups,

Lunch & clean up, Reretreat groups, Organized Recreation, Free Time, Dinner & clean up, Evening activity, Evening vesper, and lights out.

What to Bring

It can get awfully cold during the nights, and nearly as cold during the morning. The afternoons are usually sunny and warm, just what you'd expect on a beautiful summer day. Dress accordingly. Our activities include plenty of volleyball, swimming and boating. There are two hikes, basketball, a dance, and plenty of dust. Don't forget Bug spray flashlight, Bible, letter writing material, and extra money for camp picture and camp store. We encourage everyone to bring their musical instruments.

Be careful if you decide to use the camp washing machine. Items have been known to disappear permanently. Unless someone watches the machine while your clothes are washing, we do not recommend your using the washing facilities.

Rules- Read with care!

1. No alcoholic beverages or drugs of any kind allowed at camp. If you are found in possession of, or if you have consumed alcohol or drugs in any amount or any form, not limited to (1) any amount (one gulp, but etc.) and (2) any form (Beer, whiskey, grass, etc) you will be brought before the cabinet for immediate expulsion from camp. There will be no refund of camp fees and you will not be allowed to return to camp the following year. (You can attend in 2 years) LSR will provide transportation to Fresno should you need it. ~~LSR~~ is not responsible for your actions once you leave IMCA property. Letters will be sent to your minister and parents.

- 2. Campers will make full settlements for damages before leaving
- 3. Campers will see that camp is left as clean as it was upon arrival
- 4. Campers will keep cabins clean at all times
- 5. Campers will not leave camp w/o clearance from an advisor
- 6. Campers will not deface camp property

- 7. Campers will cooperate w/ cabinet in all activities and functions that must be carried thru.
- 8. No boating or swimming except at scheduled times w/ lifeguard on duty
- 9. Camp Redwood boats will not land at other docks.
- 10. Standing or tipping boats is prohibited
- 11. Lifejackets will be worn while boating
- 12. No firecrackers or fireworks (Against US Forestry Rules)
- 13. Smoking allowed only in designated areas.
- 14. Decisions concerning discipline of campers unable to abide by camp rules will be brought to the cabinet for possible dismissal from LSR
- 15. No cabin switching w/o consent by the cabinet.

This is our invitation to all of you to attend the 31st Annual Lake Sequoia Retreat. ( Funded in part by the NCJCCF ) Please read our form carefully, as there may be changes that you are unaware of...

Rev. Roy Sano will be speaking to you this year. Rev. Sano is a Professor of Theology at the Pacific School of Religion in Berkeley. He is also the active director of ACTS Asian Center of Theology and Strategies ) He is married and has several children.

Our theme this year is " Roots. " Rev. Sano's talks and subsequent discussion groups will be geared in this direction.

What do we mean by roots? We'll be discussing your background as a member of the third generation, as an asian in American society. How your lives have been affected by where you live, the social climate, and in particular, your religious commitments. How all these factors have formed the foundation to create your identity. And how these roots will guide your future.

----- VERY GENERAL SCHEDULE -----

A usual day at Camp Redwood goes like this...Wake up, morning watch, breakfast and cleanup, Rev. Sano's talk, discussion groups, lunch and cleanup, interest groups, organized recreation, freetime, dinner and cleanup, evening activity, and lights out.

-----REGISTRATION INFORMATION-----

Price for the entire weeks camp is 68.00 if we receive your completed form by postmark July 28. Price for entire weeks camp postmark July 29 to Aug 4 is 75.00.. Deadline for all registration is Aug 4!!. We absolutely must have your form by that date!! Any forms received postmarked Aug 5 or after will be returned!! Any persons bringing forms to camp itself will be turned away.

Price for part time attendance is 10.00 per day if we receive your completed form postmarked July 28. If you register after July 28 and postmark July 29 to Aug 4 there is a flat extra charge of 5.00 whether you are a part timer for One day or two days or five days. It makes no difference how many days you attend, the fee is 5.00 extra.

Send us your complete form postmark July 28 and save some bucks! Any incomplete form received will be returned immediately with threat of late fee tacked on. We prefer that you send us your check ( no cash thru the mail, please ) rather than bringing it to camp, since we do not like keeping that much money unprotected at camp. We think it is safer for us and for you, so please try to cooperate with us on this point. Make all checks payable to LAKE SEQUOIA RETREAT.

----- MORE REGISTRATION INFORMATION -----

If you are 18 yrs old or younger, we must have the signature of your parent or guardian. We also require that an NCJCCF (Northern Calif Japanese Christian Church Federation) affiliated minister or a minister approved of by LSR sign your form, no matter what your age. Should we receive your form without the proper signatures, it will be returned, and you may miss the cheaper July 28 date for registration.

If you are not a member of a NCJCCF church (but you probably are whether you know it or not) we request that you have a NCJCCF or LSR approved minister sign in the space marked-"Minister's signature-MANDATORY." If you heard about LSR from a friend, chances are that his minister is NCJCCF affiliated, and he can sign for you. If you can't find a qualified minister, contact the persons listed on page 4 for info on NCJCCF churches in your area.
