Students who apply for classified graduate standing, but do not submit all required materials (including transcripts and Graduate Record Examination aptitude test scores), at a time sufficiently in advance of the opening of a semester to permit departmental consideration, may be admitted as an unclassified graduate student. Students admitted in this way and who want to be considered to classified status must complete a special request form in the Office of Admissions between February 5 and April 15, 1968.
