Explanation

2.—University: Required for A.B., 120 to 124 semester units. For B.S., from 120 to 154 units. In column headed "gd" (grade), results of student's work given as follows: 1 or A, excellent; 2 or B, good; C, fair; D, barely passing; 3 (used before August, 1921), passed, without distinction between C and D. - (hyphen) signifies a condition; + (plus) indicates that condition has been removed. O (circle) signifies a failure; ⊕ (plus within circle) signifies failure has been removed. ✓ (check) indicates work satisfactory to date; credit to be allowed upon completion. Where unit value is enclosed in a square (□) see earlier session for unit value and grade. Inc. indicates that work of course is incomplete; P, passed without a definite grading; R.D., credited upon recommendation of department; R.B.A., credited upon recommendation of Board of Admissions. For students graduating in or after May, 1923, there are required in certain curricula, a stated number of passing grades higher than "D," according to a plan for the assignment of "grade points"; an explanation of the plan appears in the General Catalogue.

3.—Numbering of courses: Undergraduate lower division courses, 1 to 99, inclusive; undergraduate upper division courses, 100 to 199, inclusive; graduate courses, 200 to 299, inclusive; teachers' courses, 300 to 399, inclusive; certain professional courses, 400 to 499, inclusive.

4.—Transcripts of record do not ordinarily include descriptive titles of courses therein referred to, but such titles can usually be supplied upon demand.

(grade) indicate that the student has passed with the grade A, B, C, or D. A minus sign (-) indicates that the student is *conditioned*; a plus sign (+) indicates that he has made up his condition. A circle (O) indicates that the student has *failed*; a plus sign within the circle indicates that the failure has been made up. P, passed without definite grading; R. B. A., credited upon recommendation of the Board of Admissions; † denotes a course outside L & S List.
