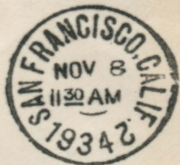

Miss Viola Imai:


God loveth a cheerful giver. (2 Corinthians 9:7)
