With so many Japanese from Los Angeles County moving in on you, I wonder if you would like to have us send you a considerable number of books from the Victory Book Campaign which are not suitable to send to the war in service. These would be mostly books suitable for men and children.

Do you have a W.F.A. project that might take care of some releases which would require reading? And if you do want these books, how many would you like? And to what point should they be shipped, and in whose care?

I talked this question with Miss Gillie, and I think she is writing to you also. We have had many Japanese branch patrons, particularly children, and we found them readers of good books, and careful of them.
