Dear Miss Bergstein:

Enclosing your letter of the 14th received this morning, I am sure that whatever books we are able to send to you will be an outright gift. However, before I can promise definitely, or state the exact quantity, I must have approval either of the Library Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, or possibly the Board itself. This procedure has not yet been settled.

If we are able to send the books to you, I am judging that there will probably be as many as 1,000 of our own stock, and I am also asking Miss Warren if it would be possible for us to transfer 2,000 or 3,000 of the Victory Campaign books. The latter would probably need to be subjected to the good services of a reading party. I shall send you definite word just as soon as possible regarding our contribution. I am certainly very glad that the idea is being so thoroughly entertained.

Enclosed is a letter received from an overseas. I will leave to the discretion of yourself and your Public Relations Director the forwarding of this letter, as I did not care to commit our idea in any way to the young man.
